The **Tree Tavern** started as a tavern and restaurant
on Crosby Place in Paterson, New Jersey.

It was a landmark location in Paterson through the 1950's and 1960's right in the heart of the city. Louis Priore founded the Tree Tavern in 1926. It was named the Tree Tavern because there was a live tree growing in the foyer. Louis's daughter Rose met and married Frank Francia in 1943. Frank joined the business and soon took over the helm of Tree Tavern. They froze the very first Tree Tavern Pizza in 1954 which makes it one of the first frozen pizzas ever sold in a supermarket. The business prospered for many years as both a restaurant and a frozen pizza company. The restaurant was ultimately closed so the Francia's could focus on the retail business.

We acquired Tree Tavern Pizza in 1992.

The current location of The Tree Tavern Wine Bar has a long history of its own.

It is located on a site that has been a tavern for many years. The early history is not very clear, but it has been a tavern since 1923. We do know that the reason it is located so far off the main road is due to the now removed commuter train station that was just a couple hundred yards away from our location. The Golden Age Club is on the old Midvale Train Station site. People would come home from their commute and walk to our location. When we first took over the property, we found old distillery equipment and a few bottles of moonshine! So, we believe it kept running during Prohibition days. The Pallavicini's ran the establishment for many years when it was known simply as Polly's. Andrew Hack bought the business about 40 years ago and ran it as Andrew's Hideaway for 25 years. We purchased the property from Andrew in 2002 to open The Tree Tavern.

As of 2023 the restaurant at 17 Park St. is 100 years old! Continuously operated through 3 owners, Prohibition, World War II, Korean War, Viet Nam, all the middle east conflicts, stock market crashes, pandemics etc. None of these catastrophes and events stopped the continuous operation of this place. Congratulations to the 3 owners who made it through, The Pallavicini's (1923-1979), The Hacks (1979-2001) and Michael Ryan (2002-2023).

To the eye, a golden hue and delicate bubbles. To the nose, intense aromas of fresh fruit, typical of Pinot varietals. On the palate, notes of fruit coupled with hints of buttery brioche.

Canard Duchene Vintage Champagne 2014 (France)

nice vintage of great quality with buttery and brioche aromas. To the eye, a pretty pale gold colour. To the nose, buttery notes, giving delicate brioche aromas on aeration. On the palate, elegant and refreshing, with brioche flavors.

Champagne as elegant as they come. Beautifully balanced, like a ballerina on pointe. With Dom's signature super creamy texture. Finesse personified! Cooler

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Champagne NV (Champagne)

\$80.00

The winemaker blends 30-45% reserve wines with grapes from as many as 50 to 60 different crus. The Pinot Noir predominance (50-55%) provides the structure that is so typically Veuve Clicquot, while Chardonnay (28-33%) adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine, and a touch of Meunier (15-20%) rounds out the blend. The long aging in our Crayères (3 years minimum for Yellow Label) gives silkiness to the Champagne.

Broletto Lambrusco Regiano 2019 (Italy)

Intense red ruby color with black-purple notes. Intense scent of violet and berry fruits. Characteristic and fresh taste but also full bodied and harmonic.

Cristal Champagne 2014 (France)

\$300.00

Golden hue with soft, glowing highlights. Fine, steady, gentle bubbles. Powerful and complex on the palate, revealing a mixture of yellow fruit (mirabelle plum), juicy, ripe fruits (nectarine), citrus peel (candied orange) and finely-roasted nuts (hazelnut). The nose is simultaneously powdery and sweet, with elegant, chalky notes. Gentle, tactile and full-bodied on the palate. The bubbles create a gentle, vibrating sensation, then the wine becomes soft, dense and juicy. But it is the chalky freshness that quickly sets the tone: the sweetness becomes energetic and intense, giving the wine an elegant yet powerful texture. Fine, textured tannins reveal a poised and vinous dimension to the wine. The finish is savoury and saline

on the nose this sparkling wine displays fruit tones of green apple, golden peach & baked lemon, notes of toasted brioche, and racy mineral aromas of gravel & limestone. Refined bubbles and a brisk acidity

The growing season yielded a radiant expression of Chardonnay at Calesa Vineyard, with inviting aromas of Meyer lemon, orange zest and hints of tropical flowers. On the palate, luxurious layers of brioche, melted butter and baking spices add depth and complexity to flavors of lemon drop, lychee and apricot, with fine-tuned acidity and subtle hints of smoke and sweet oak carrying through to a long, satisfying finish. WHITE WINES/ CHARDONNAY

2023 Chardonnay – Diatom 2023 (Santa Barbara) \$30.00

Diatom is motivated by the pursuit of subtraction and refinement. It is the polishing of a grain of rice until one has reached its ultimate inner core. We strive for a recognition of place with as little disturbance, distraction or interference as possible. The resulting wines have a sense of transparency and a purity of intent and purpose.

Chardonnay – Domaine Anderson 2018 (Anderson Valley) \$40.00

plenty of richness and complexity of aroma with hints of preserved lemon, apricot and a light reduction, reminiscent of crushed white rocks. On the palate, savory notes of thyme herb, dried flowers and grilled pear are balanced against a fresh and snappy acidity. Smooth and long finish.

Chardonnay – Domaine Passe \$40.00

Closer to Champagne than the Cote d'Or, Chablis is the northernmost region of Burgundy. This cold continental climate makes for a zesty, mineral, laser-focused expression of Old World Chardonnay –

some would even say its quintessential expression. This Chablis shows remarkable purity, and a delightful balance between acidity and roundness.

White Burgundy – Drouhin Puligny Monrachat

\$180.00

A wine of great finesse, distinguished and elegant. The colour is pure and bright, with light glints of white gold. The aromas evoke trees in bloom and white flesh fruit, like white peaches. With age, the aromas evolve towards almond and lightly grilled dried fruit. On the palate, there is a sensation of fresh silkiness. Long and persistent in the aftertaste, ending on an exceptional wealth of flavours, both floral and fruity.

White Burgundy – Pierre Labet “ Beaune”

Heady notes of petrol, matchstick, and pear. Fresh orchard fruits with good middle weight with a dry linear finish.

Chablis – Drouhin Grand Cru

\$80.00

A delicate and ample wine, easy to appreciate. The pale yellow colour is very pure, with light green reflections. On the nose, floral aromas of acacia harmonize with vegetal notes of fern and coriander. Taste notes of orange or lemon marmalade. It has a soft, round, well balanced body. The aromas of fruit are enhanced by intense mineral notes evolving towards a slightly smoky flavour. Beautiful length on the aftertaste.

Chablis - Domaine Vocoret & Fils

Baked apples, lemon curd, white rocks. Round, fleshy, full-bodied with vivid • acidity. A riper vintage showing a long, mineral finish.

Chablis – Domaine La Chablisienne (Chablis)

\$40.00

The Chablis appellation is the most important of the Chablis vineyards. Located on the slopes on both sides of the Serein river, on the famous "Kimmeridgian" soil, the Chablis express a terroir that combines freshness, minerality, finesse and complexity. Depending on the different vintages, it can be enjoyed young, with a thirst-quenching freshness or between three and eight years for certain specific vintages, which are characterized by more complexity, minerality and aromatic richness.

Chabis – Domaine La Chablisienne (1er cru) Le serene

Dense and Aromatic

Pale yellow colour, clear and brilliant with light bronze reflections. The nose is expressive, open with notes of citrus and zest. Some brioche aromas appear after oxygenation. The attack on the palate is energetic and fresh.

White Burgundy – Domaine Doudet Les Pins 2020 (Burgundy) \$60.00

Clear and brilliant color of a pale gold. The nose is powerful and expressive, fruity and characterized by purity and a singular distinction. It reveals itself in depth. The palate is graceful and mineral. It opens first with invigorating and floral notes (citrus, juniper, quince, lemon notes), then with hazelnut and almond

Chardonnay – DuMol Chloe 2020 (Sonoma) \$88.00

Traditionally the richest Chardonnay each vintage, our Chloe bottling is grown on clay soils in the warmer central district of the Russian River Valley, inland from the coastal vineyards. Distinct from our other Sonoma Chardonnays, there's no sand to be found in these soils, so this wine is layered, textural, and deeply flavored and leads with volume and generosity out front. Which is not to downplay its vibrancy or freshness, as it balances all this vineyard-derived richness with prominent poised acidity. For lovers of Californian fruit and layered opulence, this is the wine for you. The wine can be enjoyed on release and aged for up to eight years.

Chardonnay – DuMol Estate 2020 (Sonoma Coast) \$95.00

Our finest Chardonnay from the 2020 vintage and one of the greatest chardonnays we've ever bottled, the 2020 Estate typifies the style of the vintage— density and concentration, with high acidity and driving energy. It's a wine that can age and develop even greater complexity in bottle for a decade. What I love about this wine is the interplay between floral, fresh herb, and fruit characters both aromatically and on the palate. The vines' low yields this season drive the deep, rich structure so the wine is textural and chewy with powerful fruit extract. The high natural acidity picks up the wine and cuts through all this density, so the flavors echo long and clear. What a magical wine. WS

DuMol Charles Heitz Isobel 2020 (Sonoma Coast) \$90.00

a rich, full-bodied vintage, quite dense and tightly packed so needs some time to relax and unwind in bottle. It has a huge amount of rich, oily, mineral-stone character. It promises to age positively in bottle for a decade-plus, such is its inherent concentration. WS

Chardonnay – Heitz 2021 (Napa) \$100.00

In the early 1960s, Joe and Alice Heitz envisioned crafting the most distinguished Chardonnay in Napa Valley. They learned under legends like Fred and Eleanor McCrea from Stony Hill Vineyard up on Spring Mountain. With those ambitious goals in mind, we carry on their legacy through the

expression of the Quartz Creek Vineyard Chardonnay. Situated at the foothills of the Mayacamas Mountains and blanketed by the morning fog from the Petaluma Gap, this site continues to produce our most elegant and refined expression of Chardonnay. Always sustainably farmed and vinified in the classic style to evoke the purest characteristics of the land where the grapes are grown.

Chardonnay – Jason Pahlmyer 2022 (Napa) \$70.00

2022 Jayson Chardonnay achieves a beautiful equilibrium of richness, buoyancy, and intricacy. Aromas of sweet Meyer lemon, crushed almond, and grilled pineapple lead to a concentrated palate of bright lemon curd and orange blossom honey underscored by fresh pear and toasted nuttiness with a hint of baking spice. The texture is classic Pahlmeyer, plush and detailed, while the presence of bright Carneros fruit brings energy and liveness. Flavors are lifted and extended on a spine of bright acidity, the lingering finish striking an ideal balance between opulence and mouthwatering freshness.

Orange Wine – Bertrand Orange Gold

*an **explosion of** notes of white flowers, candied fruit and white pepper. On the palate, a very flattering aromatic freshness, with precise flavours and a **beautiful balance** to which the structure gives body and spirit. Sweet and fine, its texture envelops the palate.*

Cotes de Gascogne (France) - Blend

bright notes of citrus, kiwi and melon alongside a light body and refreshing acidity.

Dourthe White Bordeaux

combines appealing citrus fruit aromas of lemon and grapefruit, with an elegant mineral hint. Direct from the outset, the wine develops into a rich, fresh and lively palate culminating in an harmonious fruity and persistent finish, characterized by the well-balanced liveliness and minerality of Sauvignon Blanc on limestone soil.

Medium straw yellow colour with a fragrant bouquet rich of citrus fruit and mineral notes, with hints of Mediterranean herbs. It is vibrant, fresh and sapid on the palate. WS

Etna Bianco Superiore 2020 (Sicily)

\$40.00

The Etna Bianco Superiore Contrada Volpare 2021 smells of white-fleshed fruits, orange blossom and broom, with an accentuated citrus note, to amplify its fragrance. In the mouth, the wine has a well-rhythmic, juicy and savory sip, with a crunchy and intense finish that refers back to citrus

Etna Bianco Frontebosco 2020 (Sicily)

\$70.00

The Etna Bianco Contrada Volpare Frontebosco by Maugeri proposes itself to the gaze of an intense straw yellow color. The nose chases aromas of tropical yellow fruit, orange blossom and rose hips and notes of candied citrus fruits and Mediterranean herbs. The taste is intense and deep, fresh and mineral, with great taste-olfactory consistency. Along the fruity and citrus finish.

Etna Bianco Tenute dei Ciclopi 2020 (Sicily)

\$40.00

Intense mineral flurries of rock salt, pumice stone and sulfurous hints spread over an olfactory framework that begins with perceptions of green mandarin peel, cedar, "sbergie" and plums; continues with orange blossom, broom and chamomile and closes with elegant balsamic hints of oregano and "cucunci". Full-bodied and balanced, with a freshness supported by vibrant savoriness. Soft, at times rounded. Intense and persistent finish with citrus and mineral echoes.

Falanghina – Torre Varano 2021 (Campana)

Straw yellow with light tease of tree fruit. The taste is soft and has a long aromatic persistence. Taste: oily, pear, lemon, and lime. Nose: quince, green apple and citrus.

Viognier "K" 2020 (Washington)

\$40.00

The 2020 vintage might be the best vintage that we have ever had in Washington state history. We had an incredible growing season that was long and temperate, allowing the fruit to ripen evenly. The wines are focused, rich, complex and lively.

Greco d' Tufo – I Capitani 2019 (Campania)

\$30.00

Greco di Tufo was the first wine from Campania to establish itself seriously on the international stage and to spread the name of the Irpinia wine area for its excellent wines. It's without any doubt the oldest vine of Irpinia, imported from the Greek region of Thessaly. The confirmation of the ancient origin is given by the discovery of a fresco in Pompeii dating back to the first century BC where he explicitly mentions the "Greco wine". Cultivation of the greco vine was spread initially on the slopes of Vesuvius and later in inland areas more suited to viticulture. WS

Soave – Pieropan 2021 (Italy)

brilliant straw yellow colour with greenish hints; the delicate nose is reminiscent of almond blossoms and marzipan; good depth of fruit on the palate, nicely balanced by a zingy acidity that enhances its long length; WS

Soave Pieropan Calvarino 2019 (Italy)

brilliant straw yellow colour with greenish hints; the delicate nose is reminiscent of almond blossoms and marzipan; good depth of fruit on the palate, nicely balanced by a zingy acidity that enhances its long length; WS

Pecorino- Vignefolli 2023 (Italy-Abruzzo)

Pecorino is a light-skinned wine grape used in Italy's eastern coastal regions, particularly in Marche and Abruzzo. A classic Pecorino-based wine is dry and minerality, straw-yellow in color and has an elegantly floral bouquet of acacia and jasmine, sometimes spiced with a faint hint of licorice. Island'

Zinfandel charges out of the gate with bold scents of baked blueberries, kirsch and raspberry pie, followed by suggestions of cracked black pepper, cloves and star anise with a waft of tobacco leaf. Full-bodied, the palate is jam-packed with red and black berry preserves, framed by chewy tannins and bold freshness, finishing long and spicy. This is an undeniably powerful, concentrated and intensely flavorful wine accented by leather and oak tones. Black fruit, coffee, licorice and baked fig provide a succulent core of richness and offer impressive length and aroma.

Zinfandel – Rattlesnake 2016 (Sonoma) \$65.00 Full-

bodied with a spicy frame, this Zinfandel boasts rich aromatics and explosive dark fruit notes. Ripe black raspberry, blueberry, cedar and earth are balanced and seamlessly interwoven throughout the mid-palate....ws

Ridge East Bench Zinfandel 2017 (Santa Cruz Mountains) \$50.00

Ripe blackberry, cocoa and mint on the nose. Brambly red fruit palate with a tannic grip, finishes with notes of chapparel and licorice. L 6-7

Ridge Lytton Springs Zin Blend 2019 (Dry Creek) 750 ml \$60.00

The 2019 Lytton Springs checks in as 73% Zinfandel, 16% Petite Sirah, and the rest Carignan and Mataro. Revealing a translucent ruby/plum hue as well as beautiful cassis and red plum fruits supported by lots of savory herbs, orange blossom, cigar, and spice-driven aromas and flavors, this beauty hits the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, a seamless texture, moderate yet present tannins, and a great finish. While the Geyserville Cuvee has eclipsed the Lytton Spring in most vintages in the past decade, that's not the case in 2019. WS

Saldo Zinfandel (Oakville) \$40.00

Saldo is the prototypical Zinfandel that showcases some of Northern California's most renowned Zinfandel vineyards and regions. Dark ruby color with bold aromas of black licorice, black pepper, cherry, and baking spice. The entry is rich, full, and scintillating. The palate is mouthwatering and smooth with a hint of chocolate. The finish is voluptuous with soft, velvety tannins. G 6-8

DESSERT WINE

Domaine Bousquet Malbec Dulce (Mendoza) 500 ml \$30.00

This wine has a deep violet color, almost black. On the nose, intense aromas of ripe cherries, blackcurrant, chocolate, and coffee notes. On the palate, it's sweet with chocolate notes, jams, plums, with soft tannins and a persistent finish. WS

Sauternes – Chateau Guiraud 1er CRU 1996 (Bordeaux) 750 ml \$80.00

Stemming from an early harvest (started on the 28th of August), first time since 1883, and a very pure botrytis, 1996 Guiraud is a complex and powerful wine, built for long years. Deep yellow tinge with glittering bronze reflects. A spicy nose, of crystallized apricot, honeysuckle, peach, fresh pineapple followed by crystallized lemon but also black tea and roasted berries, vanilla notes. A very rich texture, always backed up by a really good acidity. The wine is never too heavy but on the opposite, offers the freshness of great botrytis. D 1-2

Vin de Constance (South Africa) 500 ml \$80.00

Kings vied for possession of this wine; Louis Philippe sent emissaries from France to fetch it; Napoleon drank it on the island of St Helena to find solace in his lonely exile; Frederick the Great and Bismarck ordered it; and the English Prime Minister – who had sampled it with much delight at Downing Street – made sure that regular consignments from the Cape were delivered to Buckingham Palace for the King.

“The sweet, luscious and excellent dessert wine called Constantia” soon became part of the literature of the 19th century. In Edwin Drood, Charles Dickens tells of “...the support embodied in a glass of Constantia and a home-made biscuit”, while Jane Austen recommends that her forsaken heroine try a little Constantia for “...its healing powers on a disappointed heart”.
