The **Tree Tavern** started as a tavern and restaurant
on Crosby Place in Paterson, New Jersey.

It was a landmark location in Paterson through the 1950's and 1960's right in the heart of the city. Louis Priore founded the Tree Tavern in 1926. It was named the Tree Tavern because there was a live tree growing in the foyer. Louis's daughter Rose met and married Frank Francia in 1943. Frank joined the business and soon took over the helm of Tree Tavern. They froze the very first Tree Tavern Pizza in 1955 which makes it one of the first frozen pizzas ever sold in a supermarket. The business prospered for many years as both a restaurant and a frozen pizza company. The restaurant was ultimately closed so the Francia's could focus on the retail business.

We acquired Tree Tavern Pizza in 1992.

The current location of The Tree Tavern Wine Bar has a long history of its own. It is located on a site that has been a tavern for many years. The early history is not very clear but it has been a tavern since 1910. We do know that the reason it is located so far off the main road is due to the now removed commuter train station that was just a couple hundred yards away from our location. The Golden Age Club is on the old Midvale Train Station site. People would come home from their commute and walk to our location. When we first took over the property, we found old distillery equipment and a few bottles of moonshine! So we believe it kept running during Prohibition days. The Pallavicini's ran the establishment for many years when it was known simply as Polly's. Andrew Hack bought the business about 40 years ago and ran it as Andrew's Hideaway for 25 years. We purchased the property from Andrew in 2002 to open The Tree Tavern.

This Cabernet from 2014 vintage offers plush, round aromas of dark fruit and herbs followed by a blend of blackberry, black cherry, blueberry, cassis, herbs, and mocha with ripe and smooth finish. This Cabernet Sauvignon with pleasant tannins and abundant fruit that is approachable when young, yet capable of aging gracefully. E 3

Le Petit Bordeaux 2019 (Bordeaux)

\$30.00

Crimson red with intense purple hints. Le Petit du Château de Lagarde brings us immediate pleasure. Concentrated aromas of fresh red berries. It is a gourmand, aerial wine. D3

Pacific Redwood Merlot 2018 (North Coast)

\$25.00

This medium-bodied and smooth-textured wine has a savory side to complement its good blackberry flavors. The aromas of black olive and bell pepper are typical for the grape variety when grown in cooler areas and they don't overwhelm the nice fruit impressions on the palate. D 5

Pacific Redwood Pinot Noir 2018 (Mendocino) \$25.00

Leafy aromas and beefy flavors give this medium-bodied, relatively lean and food-friendly wine a distinctive profile. It has light but grippy tannins, good acidity and fruit flavors that run to tart cherry and rhubarb. It's one of the most mainstream-tasting organic wines. I 3-4

Sweet Red wine – Del Poggio Sweet Red NV (Italy) \$25.00

This full-bodied and fruity Sweet Red wine carries notes of apricot and peach. Its balanced flavor pairs perfectly with smoked meats, Mexican dishes, spicy fare, and a day full of wanderlust. Castello Del Poggio sure represents more than a wine drinking experience, it's a way of life. Cooler

Burgundy – Albert Bichot Fixin (pronounced Fee-shon) 2011 (France) \$35.00

This red Fixin has a very attractive ruby red colour. Delicate and discreet, the nose has subtle notes of woodland undergrowth. Fleshy and robust, this crisp and oaky wine has harmonious balance. The finish is persistent with light spicy notes. G 12

Burgundy – Drouhin Cote de Beaune 2016 (Beaune) \$60.00

A true delight and a great harmony! A beautiful purple colour. On the nose, delicate and fruity aromas such as strawberry and red currant. On the palate, the tannins are refined and lend a nice roundness to the body. Elegant finish. WS

Burgundy – Drouhin Nuits St. George 2017 (Burgundy) \$80.00

Deep red colour. The aromas are powerful and elegant, with notes of cherry and blackberry, as well as hints of cedar wood evolving towards gamey touches. On the palate: beautiful balance between structure and softness. The long aftertaste is reminiscent of fruit syrups and mild spices". WS

Pommard - Patriarche 2014 (Burgundy) \$60.00

The etymology of Pommard comes from the latin word « pomarium » or orchard! There's a good reason that the hillsides of this village have been cultivated since the Middle Ages. This climat is located between the Clos Blanc and the Clos de la Comaraine next to the Clos des Epenots, and enjoys good sun exposure. It's the last parcel before the houses in the village. Pommard does not produce only red wine. Yield is about 40 hectolitres per hectare. Pommard is astringent in its first years (up to 4 years). I 10

Clos Vougeot – Patriarche 2014 (Burgundy) \$300.00

Beautiful deep red colour. Small ripe red berries, well developed nose dominated by finesse and elegance. On the palate the tannins are delicate and elegant, a lot of harmony in the middle and at the finish, completely straightforward and tender. J 5

Pinot Noir – Argyle 2019 (Wilamette) \$30.00

Argyle Pinot Noir highlights the elegance and complexity of the Willamette Valley, showcasing the purity of fruit and nimble texture the region has to offer. Fermented entirely in small, 1.5 ton lots and plunged by hand, the 2019 vintage leans red cherry, pomegranate, and spiced tea. Fresh, vibrant acidity is framed with polished tannin along with classic Argyle silky texture and persistent length. WS

Pinot Noir – B Side (North Coast) \$40.00

The B Side Pinot Noir is a brilliant ruby red in the glass with the slightest blood orange hued edge. This is a soul-filled Pinot Noir with lifted aromas of raspberry, rose petal, cherry cola and black tea. Further spiced with notes of clove and fresh forest, the aromas lead to a full-bodied, richly textured palate with layered flavors of black cherry, violets, spice and smoke. The first taste presents dark fruit flavors and cherry, with pink peppercorn, rhubarb and five-spices. Ripe, well-integrated tannins are balanced by the graceful structure. While the wine is very pretty and approachable now, it has the charm and persistence to suggest it will effortlessly age over the next 10 years and more. H 3-4

Pinot Noir – Elk Cove (Oregon) 2018 \$50.00

Deep and brooding with aromas of dark chocolate and ripe Italian plum, its dusty tannins lend structure to lush black currant and blackberry compote flavors. Finishes earthy with dried fig, black tea and pinesap. H 11-12

J Vineyards Pinot Noir 2017 (California) \$25.00

This Pinot Noir opens with aromatic notes of black cherry and baking spice. The soft, silky palate features bright, fruity notes of cranberry, fig and fresh orange peel, with hints of dark, brambly fruit, black tea and clove. I 4-5

Pinot Noir – Jayson Pahlmeyer 2018 Sonoma Coast **\$60.00**

The 2018 Pinot Noir is rich with a juicy texture. Aromas of root beer and candied marasca cherries lead to subtle notes of cinnamon, vanilla bean and custard. The mouthfeel is concentrated and expansive mid-palate. A youthful acidity brightens the palate, then finishes velvety smooth. J 6-8

Kim Crawford Rise & Shine Pinot Noir 2014 (Central Otago) **\$45.00**

Intensely dark ruby red. Intensely lifted notes of blackberries and plums. Dried thyme and sweet, spicy oak aromas give this wine an intriguing nose and balances the fruit aromas nicely. Rich and full flavors of plums, dark forest berries and spice. Ripe and luscious, the fruit flavors are well framed by silky tannins, giving the wine structure and great length. Price to go \$32.00 I 7

Marimar “Christina” Pinot Noir 2013 (Sonoma) **\$70.00**

This bottling of Cristina exhibits deep, expansive aromas of cherries and black fruits, clove and orange peel. On the palate it opens up with intense, savory flavors: rich and seductive, with great balance between oak, fruit and acidity, refined tannins and solid structure. It will continue to develop for at least another 10-15 years. I would recommend serving it at cellar temperature, between 58-60° F, and it will benefit from decanting. E 7-8

Pfitscher Pinot Nero 2019 (Alto Adige It.) **\$40.00**

The intensive scent of red and dark berries is typical of our “Fuxleiten”. The grapes used for this wine come from Montagna, one of the most adequate areas for Pinot Noir. This red wine develops harmoniously, with a full body and lasting finish. In the glass it gleams with a beautiful ruby red. WS

Pinot Noir – Rose Rock by Drouhin 2014 (USA) **\$40.00**

The 2014 Rose Rock Pinot Noir has a lovely, deep red color. The nose is floral, spicy and beautiful, with an intense, savory, character. On the palate, there are notes of dark berry preserves, a touch of caramel, black cherry, dried flowers, and tilled earth. There is clear structure and balance, with good mouth weight and a long finish. I expect that we will be enjoying this wine for 7-10 years, or more, but it offers a lot now. J 11-12

Red Blend – Chateau d' Angles Grand Vin 2016 (La Clape France) **\$30.00**

Another terrific value from the South of France, the 2016 Languedoc-La Clape Classique comes from the estate owned by a former winemaker at Château Lafite-Rothschild. A blend of 40% Grenache, 40% Syrah and 20% Mourvèdre, aged in cement tanks for 18 months, it's full-bodied, concentrated and velvety in texture, with rich blueberry, black cherry and plum. G4

Red Blend – Clio (Jumilla Spain) **\$60.00**

The grapes for this wine are made from 12 Ha -29.65 acres- of Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards and 32 Ha -79 acres- of very old Monastrell, with a very low yield. The grapes are harvested with small baskets to prevent bruising. The bunches are brought to triage tables where the best ones are selected. It spends 24 months in French and American new oak barrels where it gets a very typical complexity. The wine exhibits a glass-coating opaque purple color with an expressive nose of pain grille, underbrush, brier, mineral, blueberry, and blackberry fruit leading to a plush, opulent wine with great density, savory flavors, and a lengthy finish. «The 2015 vintage reminds me to some extent of my hometown of Bordeaux because of the high levels of rain. Flavors of tobacco, soil, slate, tar and olives go long on gritty tannins, and with a wave of the baton, it finishes on a high note of lilacs and caramel-coated coffee bean . 0 9

Red Blend – Murrietta’s Well “The Spur” 2018 (Livermore Ca.) \$30.00

The Spur 2018 is crafted from blending the classic Bordeaux varietals with Petite Sirah, which offers a distinctively California expression. Each varietal is farmed, harvested, and handcrafted individually to achieve their greatest expression prior to assembling the final blend. The 2018 vintage provides an aromatic profile of black cherry, blueberry and clove with complementary notes of graham cracker and ripe blackberry. The dark fruit aromas carry through to the palate which is framed by fine tannins, and a rich, lasting, and elegant mouthfeel. H 10

Kanonkop Kadette Blend 2017 (Stellenbosch SA) 25.00

The 2017 Kadette Cape Blend comprises 37% Pinotage, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Cabernet Franc and 25% Merlot, aged in barrel for 12 months in second-, third- and fourth-fill French barriques. The pleasant, straightforward bouquet of mint-tinged black fruit conveys an almost Left Bank personality. Dal Forno produces some of the most extraordinary Valpolicella Superiores of the Veneto. In fact, they are much like buying an Amarone--at half the price! Dal Forno produces the wine according to the same exacting standards as the Amarone, but the vines are younger (less than ten years of age) and the drying time is shorter (one month for the Valpolicella versus three months for the Amarone). The result is simply spectacular—a full-bodied wine whose ineffable combination of raisiny fruit, streaks of tar and acidity, pine-floor aromatics and pipe tobacco. L 2

Appassimento - Tedeschi Capitel San Rocco Rosso Ripasso 2012 (Italy) \$30.00
Aromas of rose, blueberry and cherry dominate. Dry with very good rose and cherry replays on the palate. It is crisp, fruity and fresh, light-to medium-bodied with a lingering finish. L 4

Garnacha- Godina Garnacha 2015 (Spain) \$35.00
This ruby/purple-colored wine offers finesse and elegance in addition to moderately intense aromas of spice box, licorice, plums and subtle oak. Rich with velvety tannins, exceptional purity, balance and length. P 4-6

Il Chioso Gattinara 2013 (Piedmont) \$35.00
Intense notes of fresh fruit with an undertone of balsamic and spices . Excellent structure with soft, balanced tannins. K3

Dolcetto – Renato Fenocchio 2019 (Piedmont) \$25.00
100% Dolcetto from 50 year old vines within the Ca'Grossa Cru in Barbaresco. Medium body, expressive aromas redolent with blueberries and tart red fruit, plush on the palate with refreshing minerals, hints of earth and a pepper spice on the finish. Approachable and complex. Certified organic farming. WS

Nebbiolo - Marchesi di Barolo Sbirolo Langhe 2012 (Piedmont) \$25.00
The color is ruby red, with medium intensity. The fragrance combines the fruity aromas of raspberries to those ethereal and spicy of violet and vanilla. The taste is dry, balanced with fine and elegant tannins. L 12

Pio Cesare Barbaresco 2013 (Piedmonte, Alba) \$90.00
A very classical style Barbaresco: elegance and velvety, with ripe and spicy fruit. Strong tannins, but elegant. Good structure and concentration. M 7

Marchesi del Grisy Barbaresco 2013 (Barbaresco) \$60.00
Cherry, menthol, rich loam and tar flavors signal this supple, vibrant red. Balanced on the tannic side for now, with a lightly astringent finish. N8

RED WINES

Nebbiolo – Costamagna Barolo 2016 (Piedmont) **\$50.00**

It is vinified with Nebbiolo grapes from small vineyards in Morra and Verduno. Maceration lasts about two weeks; it is aged for 24 months in Slavonia oak barrels and for at least one year in bottles. Elegant and soft on the palate, it is characterized by fruity and balsamic aromas, the tannicity is balanced and well integrated with the fruit. L 5

Nebbiolo – Costamagna Reseva Barolo 2013 (Piedmont) **\$90.00**

Produced only in the best vintages, it takes its name from Francesco Costamagna, ancestor of the current owners. It is obtained from Nebbiolo grapes from the "bricco", that is, from the highest and best exposed part of the vineyard "Rocche dell'Annunziata". It is aged for 5 years (Reserve), three of them in oak barrels and at least two in bottles. The color is intense ruby red with complex aromas on which ripe fruit, chocolate, mentholated and balsamic scents stand out. The large structure is tempered by the softness of the tannins, the finish is long and persistent.

PALLET

Nebbiolo - Renato Ratti Marcenasco Barolo 2016 (Piedmont, it.) **\$70.00**

Color: garnet red.

A bouquet with traces of licorice and tobacco.

Full flavored, full-bodied and elegant.

Noble and generous, glory of old Piedmont, a wine suitable for long aging, Barolo is the absolute master of the table. It conquers the palate with the conviction of strength, harmony and fullness and holds its sway at length.

Barolo Marcenasco has ancient origins. There are historical documents from the "Rigestum Comunis Albae" that bear witness to the cultivation of the Nebbiolo wine in the "Marcenascum" area already back in the 12th Century. Pallet

Nebbiolo - Viberti La Gemella Barbera D' Alba 2015 (Piedmont) **\$25.00**

Deep ruby red with and juicy red fruit nose with clear notes of blueberry and earthy touches. The wine shows a great vibrancy and full body taste, long finish.

Serve with cold meat and pepper hors d'oeuvres, pasta first course dishes, pizza, white meat, caesar salad, cheese and BBQ meats L1

Lalande de Pomerol – Chateau Siaurac 2015 (Bordeaux) \$40.00

Matured for 14 months in both vats and French oak barrels with 25% new oak. Black cherry and spice on the nose. A full-bodied, generously-juicy and very quaffable wine with great structure. It is easy to drink and goes extremely well with red meats, Sunday roasts and the promise of shared and extended pleasures. K 10

Pauillac - Chateau Lynch Bages 2015 (Bordeaux) \$300.00

A well-structured, smooth wine with red fruit aromas and elegant, well integrated oak. The suppleness and roundness of these wines lean towards requiring less storage time when in the bottle to give it its elegance, charm and seductive power. Grapes: 72% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Merlot and 11% Cabernet Franc Region: France / Bordeaux / Pauillac Maker: Jean-Charles Cazes Notes: Dark berry fruit, cherry, blackcurrant, sandal wood, leather, spices and coffee aromas. On the palate the wine shows red and black fruits such as cherry, redcurrant, blackcurrant with hints of tobacco and tea leaves. It has a high acidity, ultra ripe tannins and very good length. Pauillac- Echo by Lynch Bages 2015 (Bordeaux) \$80.00

The 2015 Echo de Lynch Bages is a blend of 66% Cabernet Sauvignon and 34% Merlot, matured in one-year-old barrels. It has a fragrant, finely tuned bouquet of blackberry, pencil lead and a touch of citrus fruit - scents that gently unfold in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with fine-grain tannin, the acidity well judged, gentle in the mouth, but building in fruit intensity to a pleasurable graphite-tinged finish. WS

Pomerol – Chateau Trotanoy 2015 (Bordeaux) \$200.00

Trotanoy is a naturally profound, complex, richly-concentrated wine with outstanding aging potential. The wine possesses a deep color and a dense, powerful nose, repeated on the palate with the addition of creamy, dark chocolate notes, and a singular concentration of flavor owed to its very old vines. Pomerol – Chateau LaTour 2015 (Bordeaux)

Latour à Pomerol, which draws its name from the tower that adorns this charming château, was acquired by Mme Loubat, who also owned Château Petrus, in 1917. Etablissements Jean-Pierre Moueix has farmed the vineyard since 1962. The vineyard is characterised by the diversity of its soils, which brings complexity and harmony to the wine: gravel and clay for a marvellous parcel next to the church of Pomerol; loam surrounding the château. The vineyard receives the same care applied to all the J.P. Moueix properties: leaf-thinning and green-harvesting to allow for optimal grape maturity followed by a manual harvest. The wine ferments in concrete vats before being aged in oak barrels. Château Latour à Pomerol is known for producing generous, concentrated wines that strike a perfect balance between elegance and power. I 4

Les Hauts de Lagarde 2018 (Bordeaux)

Dark garnet color. Smoky aromas and flavors of charred nuts, roasted berries, and clay with a satiny, crisp, dryish medium body and a medium-long nuts, craisins and cassis, and earth finish with woody, tannins. A fun earthy French red for the table or cellar. M 9-10

Haut-Medoc – Chateau Magnol 2016 (Bordeaux)

The 2016 Magnol has a delightful bouquet with blackberry, raspberry, cedar and pressed flowers scents, the oak neatly integrated. The palate is medium-bodied with fine grain tannin, well judged acidity, good body and tension with fine minerality towards the finish. N 6-7, WS

Zinfandel - The Federalist Bourbon Barrel aged 2014 (Mendocino) \$30.00

Alexander Hamilton was a man of many curiosities and talents. In his spirit, this classic Zinfandel embraces the uniquely American tradition of aging in charred bourbon barrels. Sourced from Mendocino County, The Federalist Bourbon Barrel-Aged Zinfandel marries intense raspberry and black pepper with vanilla, a touch of clove spice and rich caramel. A blend of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah and Merlot, this wine has aromas and flavors of black fruit, smoke, caramel and vanilla. F 5

Ridge East Bench Zinfandel 2017 (Santa Cruz Mountains)

Ripe blackberry, cocoa and mint on the nose. Brambly red fruit palate with a tannic grip, finishes with notes of chapparel and licorice. L 6-7

Saldo Zinfandel 2016 (Oakville)

Saldo is the prototypical Zinfandel that showcases some of Northern California's most renowned Zinfandel vineyards and regions. The word "Saldo" is of Latin origin often referring to "from here and there" or in this case, representing our sourcing of Zinfandel from regions "here and there" across Northern California.

Dark ruby color with bold aromas of black licorice, black pepper, cherry, and baking spice. The entry is rich, full, and scintillating. The palate is mouthwatering and smooth with a hint of chocolate. The finish is voluptuous with soft, velvety tannins. G 6-8

DESSERT WINE

Ice Wine – Inniskillin Vidal Pearl 2017 (Canada)(375ml) \$75.00

Ice wine (Eiswein in Germany and icewine in Canada) is a rich, flavorful and rare dessert wine. To make ice wine, the winemaker leaves the grapes on the vine, long after traditional harvest season has ended, hoping neither rain nor hungry wildlife gets the grapes first. As soon as the temperature drops sufficiently and the grapes freeze, the grapes must be picked before dawn, and pressed before they thaw. Because much of the water in the grapes is frozen, the pressed juice is concentrated, rich in flavor and high in sugar and acidity Cooler

Sauternes – Chateau Guiraud 1er CRU 1996 (Bordeaux) \$80.00

Stemming from an early harvest (started on the 28th of august), fist time since 1883, and a very pure botrytis, 1996 Guiraud is a complex and powerful wine, built for long years. Deep yellow tinge with glittering bronze reflects. A spicy nose, of crystallized apricot, honeysuckle, peach, fresh pineapple followed by crystallized lemon but also balck tea and roasted berries, vanilla notes. A very rich texture, always backed up by a really good acidity. The wine is never to heavy but on the opposite, offers the freshness of great botrytis. D 1-2

Vin de Constance (South Africa) 500 ml \$80.00

Kings vied for possession of this wine; Louis Philippe sent emissaries from France to fetch it; Napoleon drank it on the island of St Helena to find solace in his lonely exile; Frederick the Great and Bismarck ordered it; and the English Prime Minister – who had sampled it with much delight at Downing Street – made sure that regular consignments from the Cape were delivered to Buckingham Palace for the King.

“The sweet, luscious and excellent dessert wine called Constantia” soon became part of the literature of the 19th century. In Edwin Drood, Charles Dickens tells of “...the support embodied in a glass of Constantia and a home-made biscuit”, while Jane Austen recommends that her forsaken heroine try a little Constantia for “...its healing powers on a disappointed heart”. A German poet, Klopstock, devoted an entire ode to the pleasures of this sweet wine, while Baudelaire transformed it into a sensuous image for his great brooding poem “Les Fleurs du Mal”. A1
